- The Trustee is not legally bound by your nomination(s) but will take your wishes into consideration.
- Under legislation in place in October 2015, lump sum death benefits can be paid at the discretion of the Trustee direct to the person(s) or charities that you nominate without any tax liability.
- You may request that any lump sum is payable to ‘your estate’, but there may be a tax liability.
- If you nominate a child under the age of 18, an adult must receive the lump sum death benefit on their behalf. You should provide the name and address of the adult who will act for the child.
- You can change your nomination(s) at any time by completing and returning a new Expression of Wish form.

5. Data protection statement

The Trustee of the CARE Scheme, Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and the third party administrator (currently Willis Towers Watson) will use information about you to arrange and administer your entitlements (and entitlements in respect of you) from the CARE Scheme. Your personal information will be held in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. All the information requested will be treated as confidential and the details will be used only for administering your pension and dependants’ benefits; this may include sharing your information between us and disclosure to our advisers and service providers but only where it is necessary as part of providing your pension scheme benefits. We may disclose your personal information if required to do so by any legal, regulatory or statutory bodies such as HM Revenue & Customs.
